THE BANDS – Wallaby Creek Festival 2024

SUB-TRIBE From the raw, roots-driven frequencies of Aotearoa (New Zealand) comes SUB-TRIBE. From blues drenched dub, chunky skank reggae to jazz hop and ragga dancehall, SUB-TRIBE leaves no groove base unturned. **THUNDER FOX** have fast become one of Australia's most exciting and sought after live acts, shops for inspiration in the bottomless oceans of style with a wicked sense of humour to boot. **THE SEVEN UPS** This heavy groove combo from Melbourne will take you on an abstruse journey into the darker fringes of instrumental music, drifting from funk to spiritual jazz and through to psychedelic fuzz rock. The Seven Ups are your soundtrack to the dance floor at the end of the world. **BOOM SHANKO** African Roots Meets Indian Raga with Afro Moses and Shivam Rath, a unique world music fusion trio blending rhythmic African medicine music with the intricate melodies of Indian classical and modern day production. **HARDING'S HOUSE**. Writing, producing and performing original music about love, mental health, loss, addiction and other facts of life, their style could best be described as indie folk/blues, but it is best to expect the unexpected with these guys, as no two releases sound the same! **OBISUN (THE TWINE)** Obi Sun isn't just a band; it's a movement—a celebration of family, music, and the universal language of rhythm that brings people together in harmony and dance. **HONEYDRIP** A funk n Soul groove train of cosmic proportions A five piece funk explosion from Sydneys innerwest, Honeydrip's sound harkens back to a bygone era, indulging in sweet soulful vocals, rich chords and georgous string lines, then switching to raging bass lines, filthy clav and epic arena rock. **SHMONÉ AND THE BAND**. The Shmoné project's upbeat sets includes songs in Hebrew, English, Italian, and French, while exploring genres from folk and jazz to blues, electronic, reggae, and pop. **JESSE MORRIS BAND** A collection of rebel folk songs, woven into Caribbean grooves, laced with salty psychedelic-dub, and delivered via an ensemble that offers up flavours of afrobeat, soul, funk and dancehall. **AARON POLLOCK** 2020 International Blues Challenge Finalist and upbeat blues fingerpicker! Australia's record breaking new talent 'Aaron Pollock' has wowed the modern blues and folk world as one of the cleanest and most entertaining singers and guitarists internationally. **FRANK SULTANA** Winner of the 2023 Memphis International Blues Challenge Frank Sultana has been releasing his original blues music since his 2011 debut 'Blues from the Lost Motel', and in 2024 is set to release his 11th album 'Have Band Will Travel' **CALYPSO CORA** will be supporting Xavier Rudd on his entire Freedom Sessions Australian Tour 2024. This dynamic quartet weaves together the sun-drenched essence of their coastal hometown into an irresistible tapestry of sound, marrying surf-soaked guitars with indie pop melodies that captivate the spirit of good vibes. **EL MOTH** from Melbourne, some of the members have found themselves in FNQ where they have reformed the band and began writing new material and performing around the FNQ region. **SECRET TUESDAYS** Secret Tuesdays are an all woman folk band from the hills of Kuranda, singing in harmony in the rich traditions of folk, gypsy, shanties, blues and country. **WHISKEY BOAT** a Far North Queensland rock shanty band, lures you like a sirens call. **FAUX mO** are hilariously entertaining. A genre bending multiCULTural theatrical band spreading the message of LOVE through music and poetry. Reggae hip & trip hop disco & pop, faux mO play music you love to get you laughing & dancing & leave you thinking. **AMAZONAS LATIN MUSIC** with traditional instruments, traditional, folk, salsa, reggaeton, reggae and more. **MAS MINIMALS** Bringing their own brand of Alternative Blues with Swampy Rhythms and a touch of Soul **LEON TUSSIE** is a multi instrumentalist who delivers a versatile and encapsulating soundscape of grooves from every corner of the globe, combining the sounds of African Kalimba, Arabic Percussion, Hand Pan and lush synthesizers to create a mesmerising and unique sonic environment. **ANDY BRASSETT** blues/roots/soul/singer/songwriter with bottleneck slide, acoustic guitar, soulful vocals in a one-man band performance. **HOOLIA** from Argentina, mixes Spanish, English, humour and emotion. A waltz, sweet lullabies, Latino and pop vibes, even a punk song! **ELLA HARTWIG** Cape York's singer/songwriter Ella Hartwig blends her folk roots with a hint of country and a twist of pop. Hailing from Cooktown, Far North Queensland (Australia), Ella has been internationally acknowledged for her songwriting. **ROADTRIPPERS** The original exponents of Garage Country, the Roadtrippers blend the influence of their Outbackian lanscape with country, pop, folk, and blues hooks somehow ending up in a territory uniquely their own, or as Richard Fidler aptly described them, "Slim Dusty meets Jack Kerouac and the Doors, sensational! **Cooktown Music Collective**. A collection of cooktowns finest musicians
